

Crystal Symphony

Odetta

Princess Odetta, one of the major characters in the ballet Swan Lake, gave name to the unique lighting fixtures from the Euroluce 2005 collection. Classical morphology, and yet a modern look, crystal delicacy and finish, together with a strong story, are the attributes common to both this chandelier family and P. I. Tchaikovsky's romantic ballet.

Pamina

It was the famous Mozart's opera The Magic Flute that featured the character of Pamina, a beautiful princess and the daughter of the Queen of the Night. Brilliant arias of prince Tamino wandering to free the princess from prison are one of the dominant motifs of the opera. The leading couple's common journey begins in darkness and culminates in the light of a new, unsullied life. This very light is the characteristic feature of the chandelier family bearing the name Pamina.

La Traviata

The novel of Alexandre Dumas, fils, La Dame aux camellias inspired Giuseppe Verdi to compose the opera La Traviata ranking today among his most famous works. The story of a Parisian girl - a demimondaine giving an insight into her emotional awakening and unsatisfied yearning for genuine love, has become a classic. The girl's moving story is engraved in some of the components characteristic of the La Traviata chandelier family.

Lucia

Gaetano Donizetti's opera Lucia di Lammermoor is based on the motifs of the historical novel by the Scottish writer Sir Walter Scott. Since its Naples premiere in 1835, the opera is still in repertoire at all big opera houses. Classic, elegant shapes together with the amber shade of glass parts are the dominant features of the Lucia lighting fixture, which can justly decorate the scenery for Donizetti's opera.

Eroica

Beethoven too was one of those composers of the world who found their second home in Bohemia, a country in which they met with appreciation and good conditions for their work. Eroica Symphony was influenced by the ideas of Enlightenment and Great French Revolution. The freedom, liberty and rebelliousness of Beethoven's music gave significant dramatic evidence of their time and produced a new creative exploit. The carmine color and the austere delicate shape of the Eroica fixtures get the best from its classic yet still modern model.

Desdemona

In opposition to the Otello lighting fixture, our designers created a lighting fixture made of carmine glass. This color has a special dramatic charge. It creates an impression of deep feelings and love that faithful Desdemona felt for Otello. Many intimate secrets are hidden in this dark red color, and your creativity may help you to reveal them.
